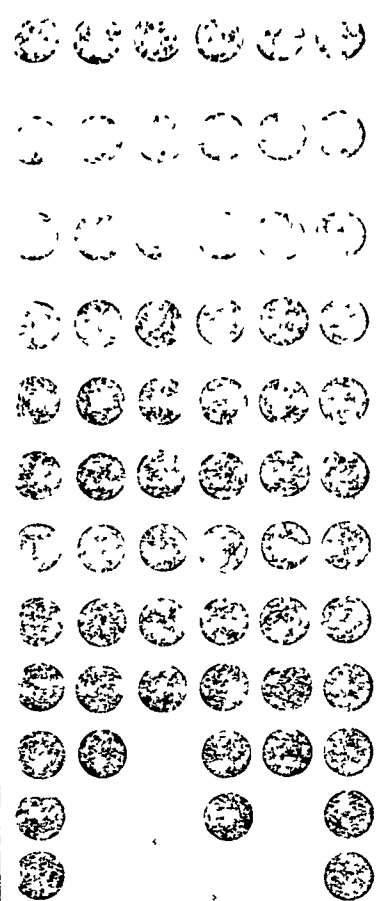
Henry R. Nixon, director of the department's Bureau of Plant Industry, said prolonged wet weather promotes the development of fungus and bacterial plant diseases.
