## How Reliable Is The "Eye-ball" Method Of Evaluating Steers?

Just how reliable and practical is the "eye ball" method of selecting and evaluating a "modern" muscular beef type steer? And when you look at cattle, how can you tell where "muscle" ends and "fat" begins?

Iowa State University scientists have sought answers to these questions and reported on their studies at the 59th Annual Meeting of the American Society of Animal Science at the University of Nevada, Reno.

Although it is readily ap-

parent that there is variation between body form and carcass composition of beef steers of similar weights, just how much was discovered in work done at Iowa State University. There animals were slaughtered and then their carcasses were chilled and subsequently frozen in a normal standing position. After freezing the "standing carcass" for 72 to 96 hours, photographs were taken and the hide, head and shanks removed. Results from measurements taken showed that the most heavily muscled steer had a carcass of 66 percent lean while the fattest steer had 43 percent lean. Likewise the best muscled steer had only 18 percent fat while the fattest steer produced 44 percent of its body weight in fat.

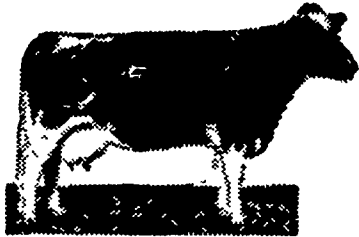

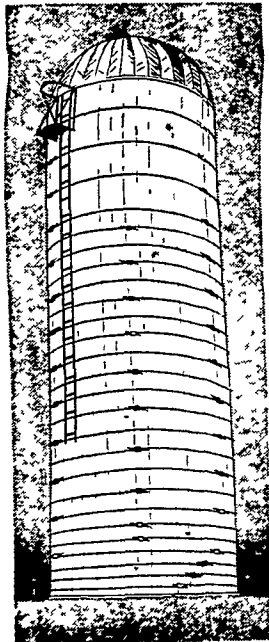

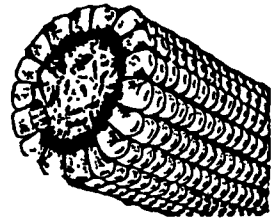
