Every grand champion in the 18th Southern Lancaster County Community Fair this week, was a two-year-old except one. In the largest dairy show ever staged at the Quarryville event, 67 showmen paraded their entries on the community park lawn Wednesday afternoon, for judge Jonas Gruver, York Co. It was the first time an open show had been featured.

J Robert Book, Kirkwood R1, set the pace for the Guernsey open show by taking top honors with his Blakeford Nances Bellflower two-year-old heifer that stood 11th at the All American show at Harrisburg last week. Bellflower was fresh January 4, 1967 and has produced 10,279 pounds of milk and 465 pounds of butterfat in 260 days.

Book teamed with Stanley Graver, Lancaster R7, for reserve grand champion.

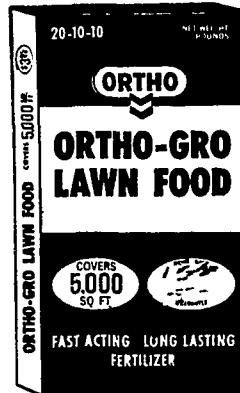

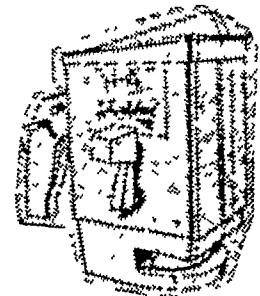
