CORN PICKERS ARE DANGEROUS

Accidents are more likely to happen when corn pickers are not in good working condition, caution extension agricultural engineers at Penn State University. Carelessness around corn pickers and other heavy mechanized farm machinery can result in painful and crippling accidents. Ice cream and other frozen dairy foods were consumed last year at the same record-setting level — 21.3 quarts per person -as in 1965. Per capita use of ice milk reached a record high of 50 quarts.
