CATTLE 4800 - Compared to last week's close, slaughter steers uneven, high-Choice and Prime steady to 25c lower, Good to average Choice steady to 25c higher; cows steady; bulls steady to 50c higher, advance mainly on Utility and Commercial; Feeder steers over 800 lbs 50c lower, wts under 800 lbs steady to weak. Supply included an estimated 30 percent slaughter steers, 15 percent cows and bulls with the balance largely feeder steers.
