**Safe Hunting Tips Offered By Specialist**

Fall and hunting go together. Sometimes, hunting and accidents also go together.

To help avoid the likelihood of a hunting accident, Miss Audra Robertson, University of Missouri extension safety specialist, offers the following tips.

—Wear bright, blaze-orange hat and vest. They are easily seen by other hunters.

—When crossing a fence alone, unload your gun and lay it down. Cross the fence, then retrieve the firearm — stock first.

—When crossing a fence with a companion, one person holds both guns, muzzles up, while the other crosses the fence.

—Unload your gun or open the action before you cross or jump a ditch or small stream.

—Keep the muzzle pointed forward, either up or down, not horizontal, while carrying a gun.

—Constantly check the area in which you are hunting for other people, houses, and livestock.

—Keep the gun barrel free of snow, mud, or other restrictions.

—Know your companions' location at all times.

—Be sure it's game before you aim.

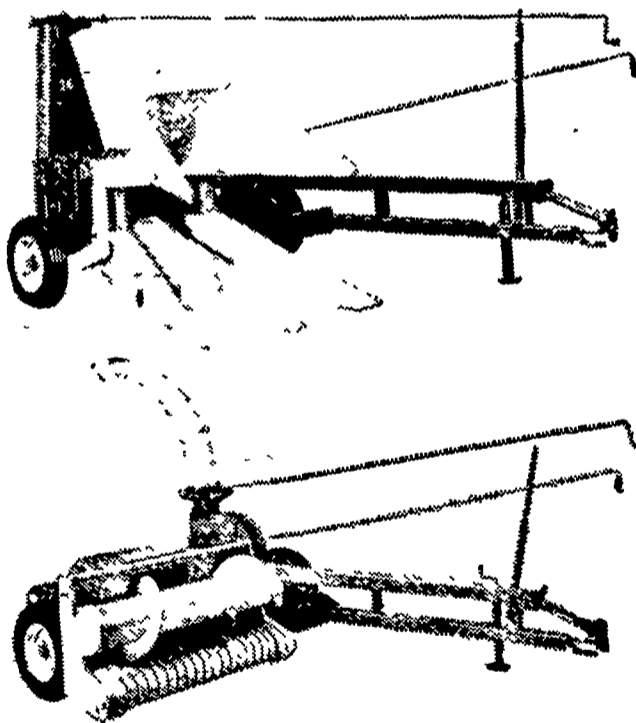
