

**Archery Deer Season
Open Today, Sept. 30**

Bow and arrow hunters will open Pennsylvania's 1967-68 seasons for big game when they start stalking whitetail deer this Saturday.

The state has one of its largest deer herds in years, and conditions are favorable for archers to establish a new record for number of whitetails taken by bowmen in a single license year. During the 1966-67 seasons, archers set the

present record as they took 2,337 deer.

There will be 24 hunting days during the regular statewide archery deer season. The regular season closes October 27, one day before the opening of the general small game season. Sunday hunting is prohibited.

An extended 11-day archery season will be held starting December 26. Use of bow and arrow is also permitted during the regular antlered and antlerless seasons.

Hunting hours for bowman

will be from one-half hour before sunrise until sunset.

As in the past, archers are permitted to take one deer of either sex. If a hunter is successful in bagging a deer during the archery season, he is not permitted to kill another whitetail during the regular gunning season.

In addition to a regular resident or non-resident hunting license, an archery license is required to hunt deer with bow and arrow. Archery licenses are available from any county treasurer for \$2.15 or from the Department of Revenue, Harrisburg, for \$2.00.

Hunters are reminded that there is lush vegetation due to increased rainfall this year, and that dense cover reduces visibility. Bowmen should be extra cautious and sure of their target while chasing whitetails.

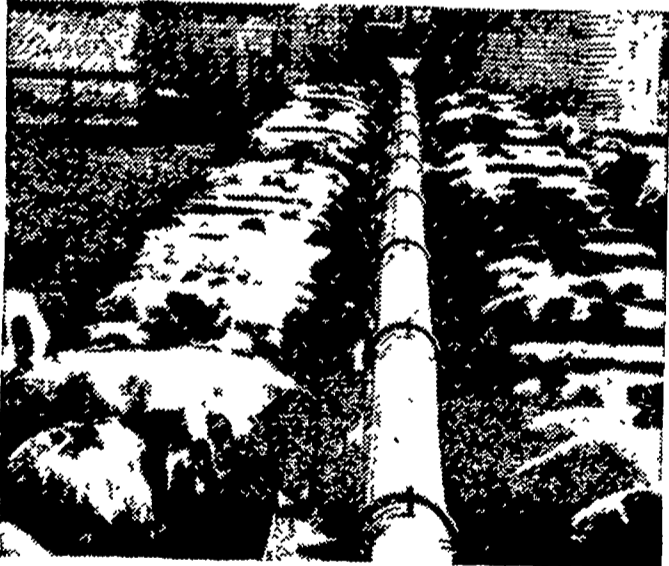
