Also re-elected were Elmer L. Huber, vice chairman, and John J. Herr, regular member.

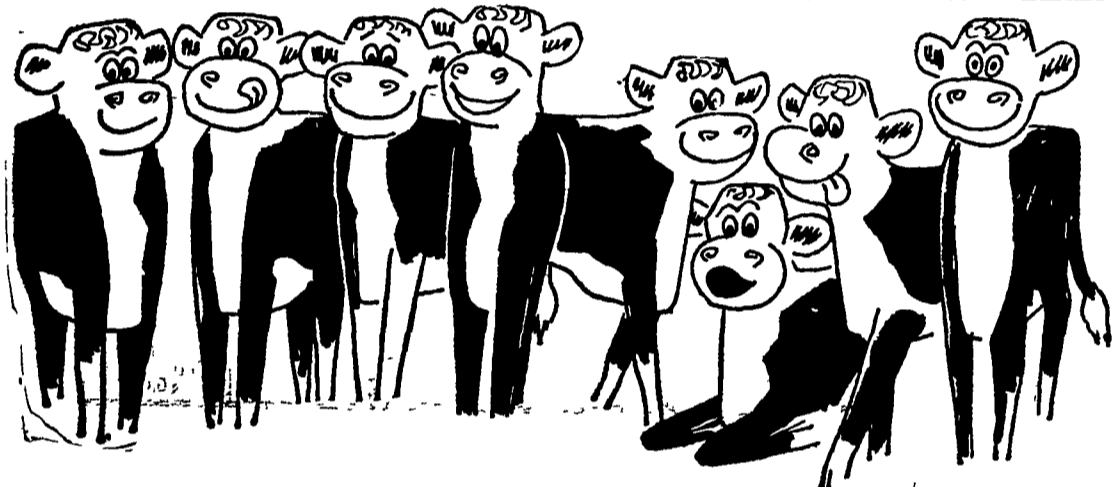
First alternate is Forney Longenecker and second alternate is Jacob C. Stehman.
