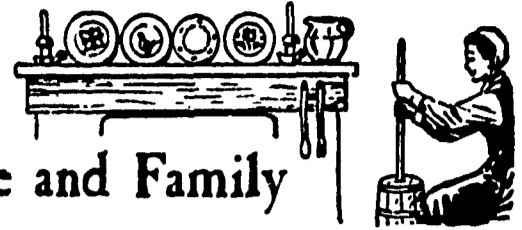
The program was the annual Food and Plant Sale with Mrs. Leon Thomas as auctioneer
