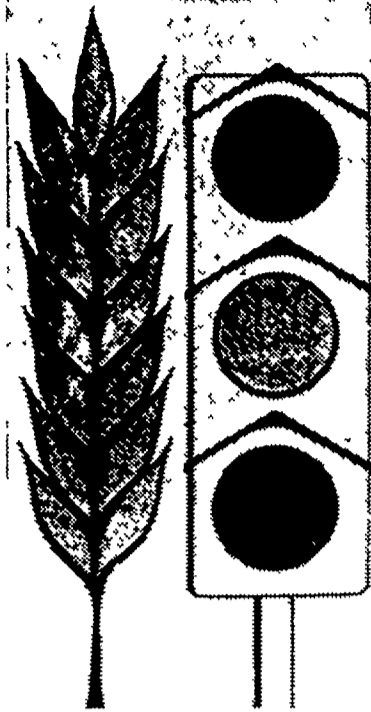

Plywood Group Offers Farrowing Shed Plans

Plans for a portable, plywood farrowing shed are available from the American Plywood Association.

The shed is designed in 8 x 20-foot sections, each with four farrowing stalls and eight litter areas. When two sections are placed together, the shed will accommodate up to eight sows and their litters in a fully-enclosed shelter. For added strength and racking resistance, the shed has a 3/4 or 7/8-inch ply-

wood floor. Sidewalls and roof also are plywood.

Individual free copies of the plan, which has been revised to conform to the plywood industry's new Product Standard 1-66, can be obtained from the American Plywood Association, 1119 A St., Tacoma, Washington, 98401.
