

GRANGE NEWS

Fulton Grange #66 met December 11 at Oakryn Master, Clifford W Holloway Jr conducted the business session when the Grange went on record opposing HB 1093, SB 1062, SB 253 and HB 1521 in the State Legislature. HB 1093 is the bill to authorize sale of liquor on Sunday when December 31 falls on that date. SB 1062 would permit Sunday sales of liquor approved by a county-wide refer-

endum. SB 253 would give the power to condemn a deed restriction and thereby prohibit full use of private property by its owner. HB 1521 is the highway land grab bill.

The Grange favors HB 197 which mandates drivers license suspension for refusal to submit to a chemical or blood test for intoxication. They are in support of Senator Dirksen's resolution in Congress to permit Bible reading and the use of non-denominational prayer in our schools.

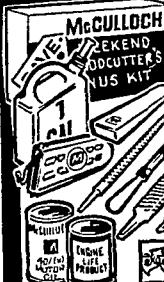

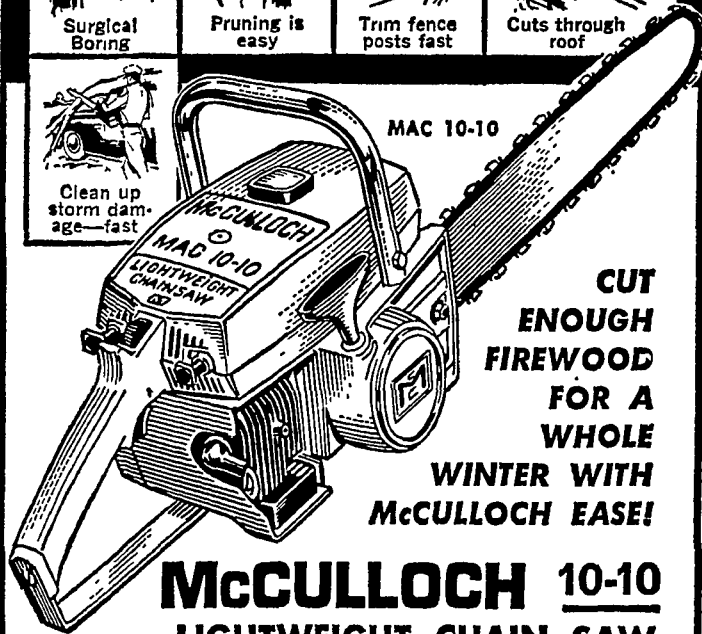

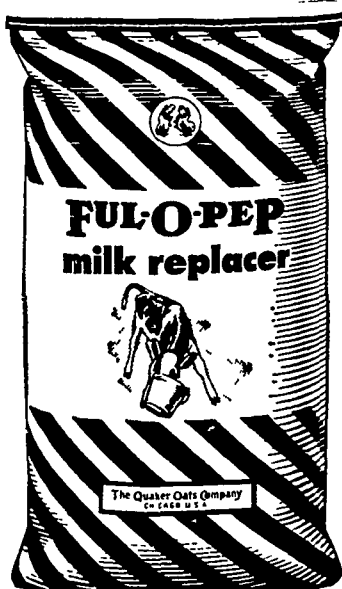
