NEPPCO Exposition Set For Harrisburg October 8-10

The 1968 NEPPCO Exposition will be held in the Farm Show Building, Harrisburg on October 8-9-10. The Penn Harris Hotel has been designated as the headquarters hotel.

The decision was made by the NEPPCO Executive Committee at an all-day meeting on December 2. Principal reason for the decision was that the two hotels in Washington, D.C. could accommodate the NEPPCO Show—Sheraton Park and Washington Hilton—did not have suitable dates available in 1968 anytime from Sep-

tember 15 through November 15. In fact, we could not obtain Tuesday - Wednesday - Thursday dates between September 15 and November 15 at either of these hotels until 1978.

Since it was imperative that they settle on a site and dates for the 1968 show before the first of the year and since the NEPPCO staff did not have the time to thoroughly check out sites in other cities in the Northeast, the Executive Committee voted to return to Harrisburg for 1968 and to continue to investigate other possible sites for 1969 and later years.
