

## Career Production Levels For Area Holstein Cows Listed

Lifetime milk and butterfat production levels for Registered Holstein cows in this area have been announced by Holstein-Friesian Association of America. The individual animals have been credited with career production totals exceeding 100,000 lbs of milk under official testing supervision.

Because of current replacement heifer rearing and purchase costs, cows that stay in the herd longer and achieve high lifetime production have proven to be more profitable. The Holstein Association has more than 26,800 cows on file that have attained the 50-ton production milestone.

## Europe Is Potential Buyer Of U. S. Wheat

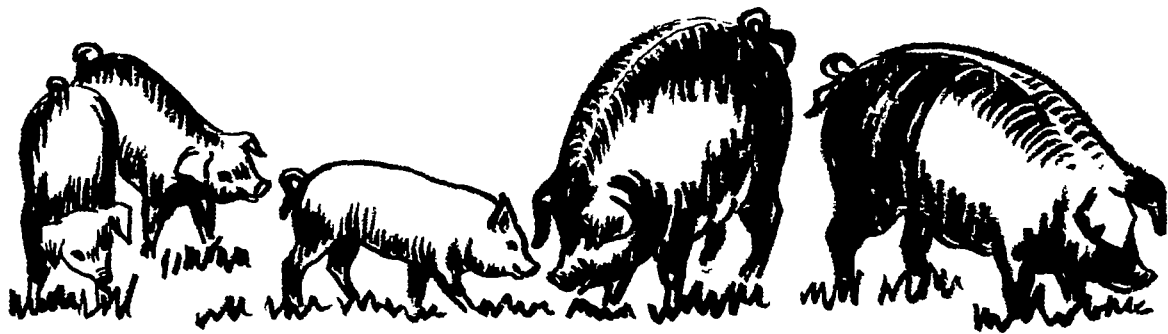
U. S. wheat producers can maintain their fare share of the European market if we consistently maintain supplies at competitive prices, according to a report recently received by Fred G. Seldomridge, chairman, Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation County Committee.

The local farm leader cited the report of a U.S. export promotion team which recently visited Europe to acquaint foreign buyers with U.S. wheat supplies and quality. The team reported that European traders like the U.S. system of selling wheat which offers greater va-

riety in types of wheat than other systems and also makes use of the commercial marketing channels and trading practices, with minimum participation by the government.

Noting that U.S. export wheat has improved in quality in recent years and is generally accepted by European millers, the export promotion team emphasized that the market is highly competitive at this time, due to large world wheat supplies. The team concluded that U.S. farmers and exporters will need to use all the merchandising tools available to meet buyer requirements. Among these are such practices as supplying samples of test-milling and meeting special quality requirements—selling wheat to specification.

Seldomridge said the team found that there is a surplus of soft wheat in Western Europe at this time. Soft wheat sales in European markets will not likely be large in the period just ahead.
