Witmer, Willow Street, Pa., has completed an official DHIA actual production record of 12,180 pounds of milk and 640 pounds of butterfat, in 305 days 2 times a day milking, according to The American Guernsey Cattle Club.

Also two registered Guernsey cows in the herd of Jerome H. Rhoads, Kirkwood, Pa. have re-

cently completed top official DHIR records. All cows were milked 2 times a day. The testing was supervised by Pennsylvania State University.
