

### AAMA Is Seeking An Improved Regulatory Program For Broilers

The American Agricultural Marketing Association is seeking an improved regulatory program for the broiler industry under the direction of the Packers & Stockyards Administration of the US Department of Agriculture, according to Kenneth Hood, manager of the Association.

This was among several recommendations made by the AAMA broiler advisory committee at its recent meeting and approved by the Association.

The Association approved a committee recommendation that AAMA encourage the American Farm Bureau Federation to obtain more adequate funds to administer the Packers & Stockyards Act.

Another recommendation approved by the Association was that AAMA encourage the broiler industry not to increase broiler production in 1968 over 1967, and that the situation be reviewed later this year relative to making a recommendation for 1969.


The leadership of AAMA was asked to use its influence with all lending agencies and encourage them to use more discretion in lending money for new poultry house construction and that an information and publicity program be implemented relative to the economics of broiler production.

The Association approved a recommendation that one or more growers be appointed by AAMA to meet with national contractors for negotiating purposes, along with one or more AAMA staff members.

The committee recommended that AAMA encourage the American Farm Bureau Federation to continue working with the poultry division, US Department of Agriculture, toward the objective of constantly improving the poultry inspection service, including the further development and implementation of standardized inspection criteria and procedures.

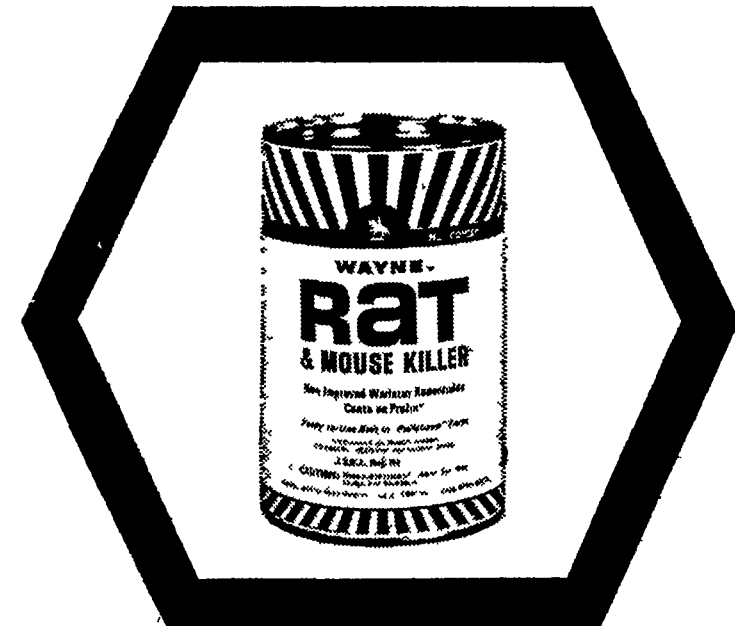

charges if you complete the payments ahead of schedule.

#### Launder Electric Blankets

Wash electric blankets. Dry-cleaning fluids can damage the insulation which covers the electric wiring.

Disconnect all removable parts before washing and follow the laundering directions which came with the blanket.

Electric blanket manufacturers suggest short wash, rinse, and spin cycles. Wash in warm or cold water.

Unless directions specify, do not machine dry the blanket. Heating elements in electric blankets can be overdried.

#### Frozen Dough Gains in Popularity

More and more homemakers are finding the convenience of

frozen dough as seen in the recent growth of frozen dough sales.

White frozen bread dough is the most popular but raisin, raisin-cinnamon, cheese, and rye are also available.

Prices for frozen white dough average less than prices for already-baked white bread.

#### Tips on Buying and Selecting Potatoes

Potatoes are sold by type, seldom by named varieties.

Some potatoes are labeled for baking, but you can bake other types of potatoes successfully.

Rough, red types, and round, white potatoes are usually best for boiling, frying, and salads.

Round russet type potatoes are all purpose.

Large, long oval Russet Burbank is heavily netted, has numerous shallow eyes, and is usually best for baking.
