heat 2 to 3 minutes, or until the coconut is brown.

### PENUCHE FROSTING

- 1/2 cup butter
- 2/3 cup granulated sugar
- 1/4 cup molasses
- 2 tablespoons evaporated milk
- 2 cups sifted confectioners sugar

Melt butter in saucepan. Add granulated sugar and molasses. Bring to a boil; reduce heat and boil 2 minutes, stirring constantly. Remove from heat; cool. Stir in evaporated milk. Gradually stir in confectioner sugar; beat until thick enough to spread. Makes 1 1/2 cups.

### MOLASSES TAFFY FROSTING

- 1 egg white, unbeaten
- 1/4 cup water
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 tablespoons molasses
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla

Combine egg white, water, sugar, molasses and salt in top of double boiler. Beat over rapidly boiling water with rotary beater or electric mixer, until frosting stands in peaks. Remove from heat; add flavoring. Beat until of spreading consistency. Frost cake. If desired, garnish with nuts. Enough for tops and sides of two 8- or 9-inch cake layers.

## Ladies, Have You Heard?...

### Give Leather Garments Special Care

Clean suede or leather garments before storing.

Have matching purse or boots cleaned at the same time so colors can be matched as nearly as possible when natural oils are restored or garment is redyed.

For emergency spot or stain removal, do not use cleaning fluids or rough wire brushes; they'll cause white or light spots.

A soft bristle brush or damp sponge is best to use around pockets, cuffs, and necklines.

Avoid storing suede and leather garments in plastic bags which do not permit free circulation of air. If placed in these bags, garments will become hard and dry.

Store in a cool place.

### For a Change, Serve Flank Steak

Flank steak is a boneless steak with very little fat. Because it's a less tender cut of meat you'll want to braise it.

Use moist heat to cook the steak.

You can marinate the meat and slice it very thin.

Because flank steak has a well-developed flavor you can stuff it with a good bread stuffing or make a swiss steak.

Flank steak is what you want to make London broil.

Count on about three servings from each pound of flank steak.

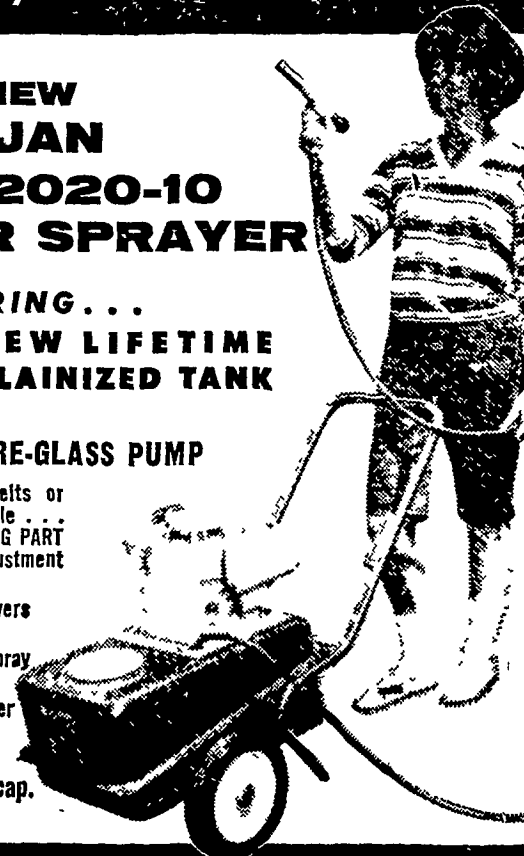
