Dean Snowball, another member of the family is Good Plus with this record: 5-5 307d 16,063m 628f. Her Milk and Honey daughter made 2y 11,651m 468f.

The Agnes family has these members now in the Jordanville R1 herd: Dean Bevie, Good Plus, 6-1y 307d 17,873m 804f Bevie's two Ivanhoe daughters are Vichi, Very Good, 4-1y 353d 21,054m 924f, and Connie, Good Plus, 4y 258d 11,196m 523f Vichi and Connie each have a Model daughter making 10,000 lb milk records as senior yearlings Conne's Dictator daughter made 14,195m 564f as a two-year-old

A twice 700 lb butterfat cow, Lindenhof Butterfinger's Thea, is the fine Registered Guernsey cow that has founded the favorite family of K D and Else

Linde, Oxford R1 Thea was a daughter of Osborne Hill Peresa's Anne who traced back to Osborne Hill Baron's Theda a Gold Star Dam Thea's sire was the famous Curtiss Candy Butterfinger

The Lindenhof foundation had several owner-sampler records as a young cow and made an official DHIA test the following 2 excellent records: 5-4y 14,445m 4.9% 702f and 6-3y 15,849m 4.7% 747f.

Thea has three daughters with records in the herd, the highest record cow being Ruth with 3-1y 305d 13,422m 4.5% 610f Theda has four records from 505 lb of butterfat to 580, and Thida has nearly 600 lb. of butterfat as a four-year-old.

Thea also had four daughters, two of which have mature records over 501 lb. of butterfat and a great granddaughter which has just finished a senior yearling record of 305d 10,655m 4.6% 486f.

Another granddaughter of the foundation cow has just finished her first lactation with this 2-y record: 305d 10,462m 5.1% 533f.

Great, Great, Great,
Great Granddaughters

A grand old Lucifer daughter that lived two weeks short of 19 years, founded the fine Beets family at John E Kreider's Trout Spring Farm Trout Spring Lucifer Beets was born Nov. 17, 1947 and died Nov. 1, 1966. She left many pleasant memories, offspring and a lifetime produc-

tion of 211,092 lb. of milk and 8,035 lb. of butterfat. Neighbors used her sons and, of her three daughters, two remain in the herd.

Betsy, the youngest daughter of Beets, has in four lactations 78,489 lb. of milk and 3000 lb. of fat.

Beth, another daughter by Hillmac Sovereign is Very Good and Gold Medal and is herself almost 15 years old. Her best record is at 9y when she had 20-389m 4.1% 835f and she has lifetime credits of 174,856m 6,821f and still doing well. A granddaughter of Beth topped the Reading Sale in 1966 at \$1220, and a son of the Gold Medal Dam is now the Excellent herd sire in the Kreider herd. One of his daughters has completed her second lactation with 19,156m 4.8% 911f.

There are now two heifers in the herd that are great, great, great granddaughters of Beets, the foundation cow.

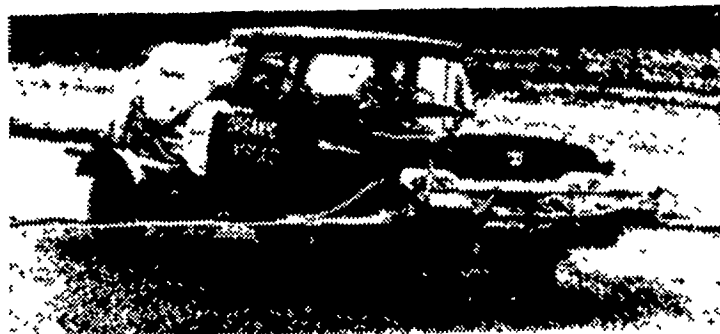
