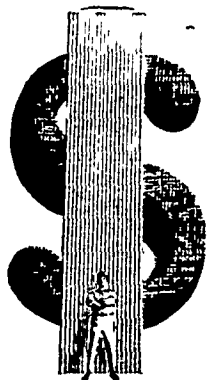
## PENN MANOR 4-H CLUB

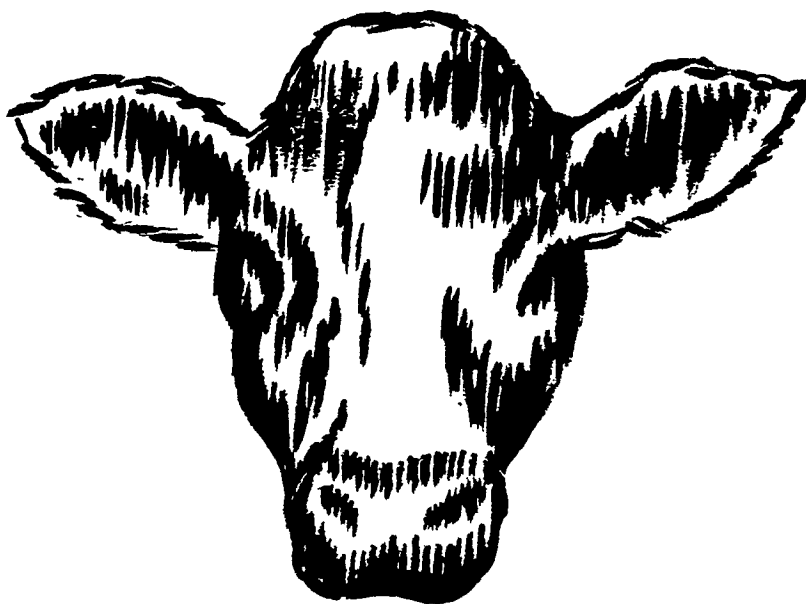
