Control Weed Seeds; Have Better Garden

"Don't let those weeds take over your garden," says Frances R. Gouin, a University of Maryland horticulturist. They not only compete with your plants for water, nutrients, light and air, but weeds also make an excellent home for insects and disease-causing organisms," he cautioned.

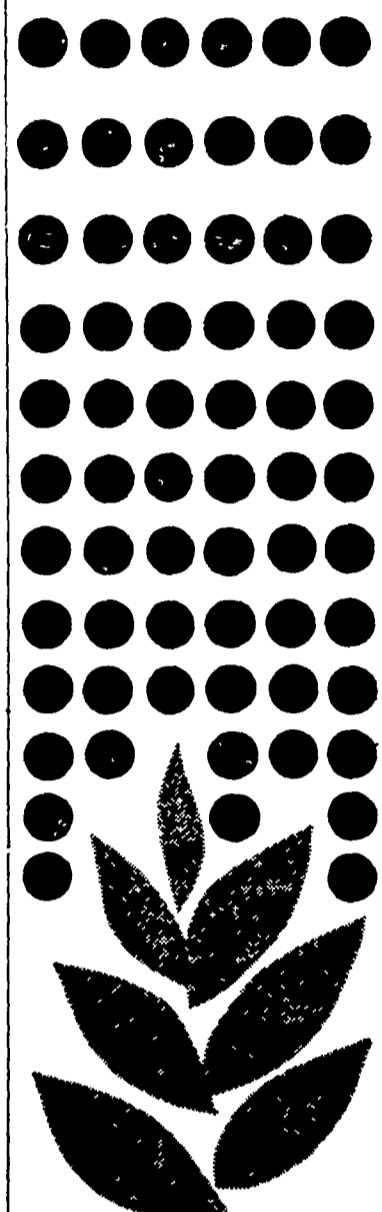
One way of not being bothered with weeds for some time to come, is to do a good job controlling them for at least 2 to 3 years. Generally, complete control of weeds for one year reduces their numbers for eight years.

Each year weeds distribute billions of seeds on the soil. Depending on the type of weed, many of the seeds will germinate the first year. However, many of the seeds remain in the soil for several years before they germinate. In this way weeds in-

sure their survival. So it's up to you to get on the side and clean up that garden now for more leisurely gardening next year.

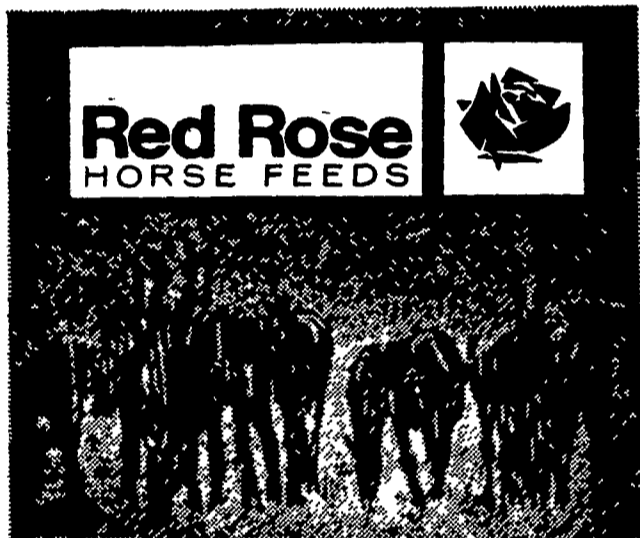
