Best Use of Freezer

To get the most from your freezer, use it efficiently. Louise W. Hamilton, Penn State extension foods and nutrition specialist, suggests you use last year's frozen fruits and vegetables before you stock up on this year's produce. Research shows that fruits and vegetables lose quality with long storage so use the oldest packages of food first.

Sewing With Wool
