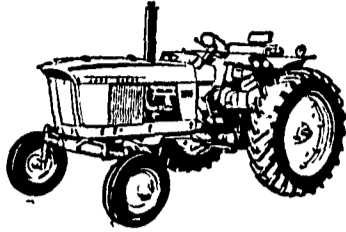

frozen, thawed
medium grapefruit
Lightly saute onion in butter
margarine. Stir in bread
cumbs, salt, pepper and all-

spice; remove from heat. Ar-
range salmon steaks in a well-
battered, shallow baking pan.
Peel and section grapefruit, re-
moving all white membrane and
reserving any juice. Pour grape-
fruit juice over salmon, then
spoon onion crumb mixture
evenly over fish. Bake at 450 de-
grees for 10 minutes. Arrange
grapefruit sections on top of sal-
mon and continue baking at 375
degrees for 15 minutes, or just
until fish flakes easily with fork.
Garnish with sliced stuffed
olives. Makes 6 servings.

The small muscle on one side of the bone is the tenderloin muscle, the tenderest muscle of all in the beef carcass.

Buy T-bones at least 1 inch thick and with marbling or threads of fat for a juicy, tender, flavorful steak. Fat adds more flavor.

Look for USDA Choice grade for tender T-bones.

Make Use of Label Information
Recent legislation requires that package labels now carry important information for you.

It is placed so you can easily see it and in print large enough to read.

New contents are given in terms of total ounces, in terms of pounds and ounces, or quarts and pints, and without partial size designations.

The main reason for placing total ounces first is to make it easier for you to compare prices per ounce and make price comparisons.

The law also requires the common name of the product, a list of ingredients, and name and address of manufacturer, packer, or distributor be given on the label or package.
