Weekly Cattle — Compared with the previous Friday, slaughter steers steady, heifers 25-75 lower, cows steady and bulls unchanged. Overall finish of slaughter steers most attractive in recent weeks at 15 percent Prime and 73 percent Choice compared with 14 percent Prime and 72 percent Choice last week and 13 percent Prime and 71 percent Choice last year. Average cost and weight for the week estimated at 27.75 and 1170 compared with 27.58 and 1163 lbs. last week and 26.68 and 1160 lbs. last year. Local receipts this week 15,400 last week 17,800 last year 19,200.
