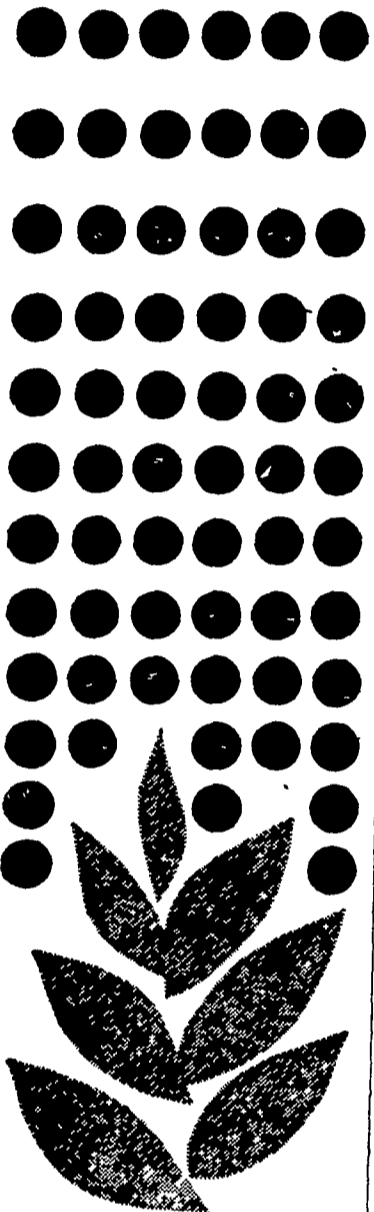

Hatmaking For Pleasure
Enjoyment of your leisure time doesn't have to find expression in organized activities. It seems to be determined more by your individual capacity to respond to your surroundings and the capacity to create something with your hands.

Many persons have found enjoyment and profit in leisure time by creating hats. A hat may be as simple as a few feathers, a bunch of flowers, or a yard of ribbon but, knowing some principles involved can help you create your own bonnet.

If hatmaking is a new venture for you, you'll want to check your techniques before starting. A correspondence course, available from The Pennsylvania State University, is an excellent guide for the beginner.

The course provides all the instructions needed for fashioning hats of fabric, straw, flowers, felt, and feathers. Supplies you'll need and where to buy them are listed. One section of the course is on renovating and trimming hats. Illustrations show hat contours suitable for various shaped faces.
