peaches are gaining good size. The Bartlett pear crop is generally excellent, although the size is smaller than last year in many areas. The Erie county grape crop started showing color about August 25, but the cool weather last week was not favorable for ripening.

VEGETABLES: Condition of vegetable crops varies across the State, with crops in good condition in the western counties, particularly, and where irrigated. Cucumber yields are mostly good, with cukes light and of good quality. Celery harvest is about one-third to one-half completed and should continue until November. Sweet corn harvest progresses, with yields and quality mostly good to very good. Fall spinach is being adversely affected by the hot dry weather. Fall cabbage is progressing well, and looks better than the summer crop.

them. Parboil 3 to 5 minutes if you're going to stuff the peppers.

Use Leftover Fresh Corn

If you've prepared more ears of corn-on-the cob than you can eat, cut cooked corn from ears and use in omelets, fritters, muffins, waffles, pancakes, tossed salad, cream-of-fresh-corn soup, and casseroles.

Buying Tips for Cantaloupes

Look for a smooth, symmetrical, shallow stem scar. Netting of the skin should be thick, coarse, and stand out in bold relief over surface of the melon.

Background color of skin between netting should have changed from green to a yellowish-buff, yellowish-gray, or pale yellow.

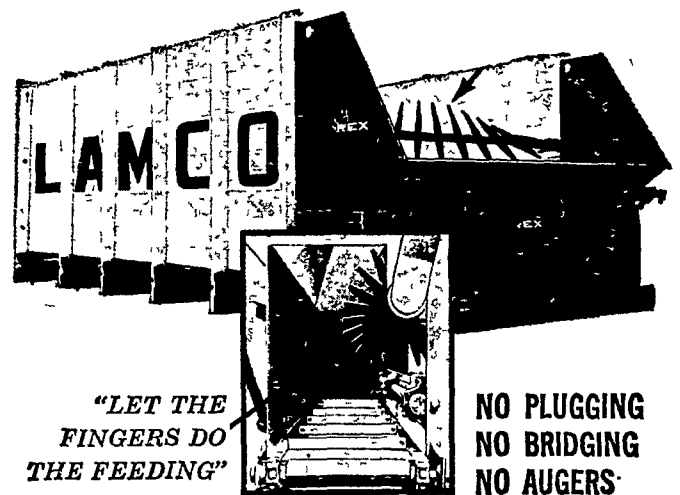
