

# Weekly Poultry Report

## Eastern Pennsylvania And New Jersey

Prices of light type hens generally held unchanged, however trade advices indicate slightly higher bids reported in some instances failing to secure supplies. Offerings somewhat lighter than past several weeks and generally held with firmness in view of current high egg prices. Heavy hens limited in offerings with occasional sales noted ranging 13½-15c. Prices paid at farm: Light type hens 6½-8¼, mostly 7½-8c. Heavy Type hens TFEWR.

**TURKEYS** — Trading generally limited to contractual agreements as processing plants operate near capacity in some quarters. Sales too few to report prices.

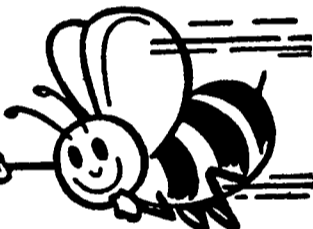

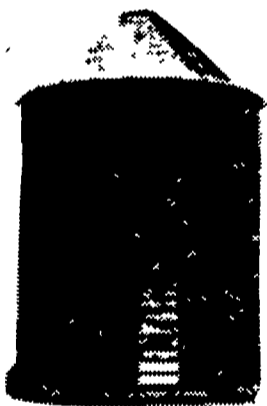
