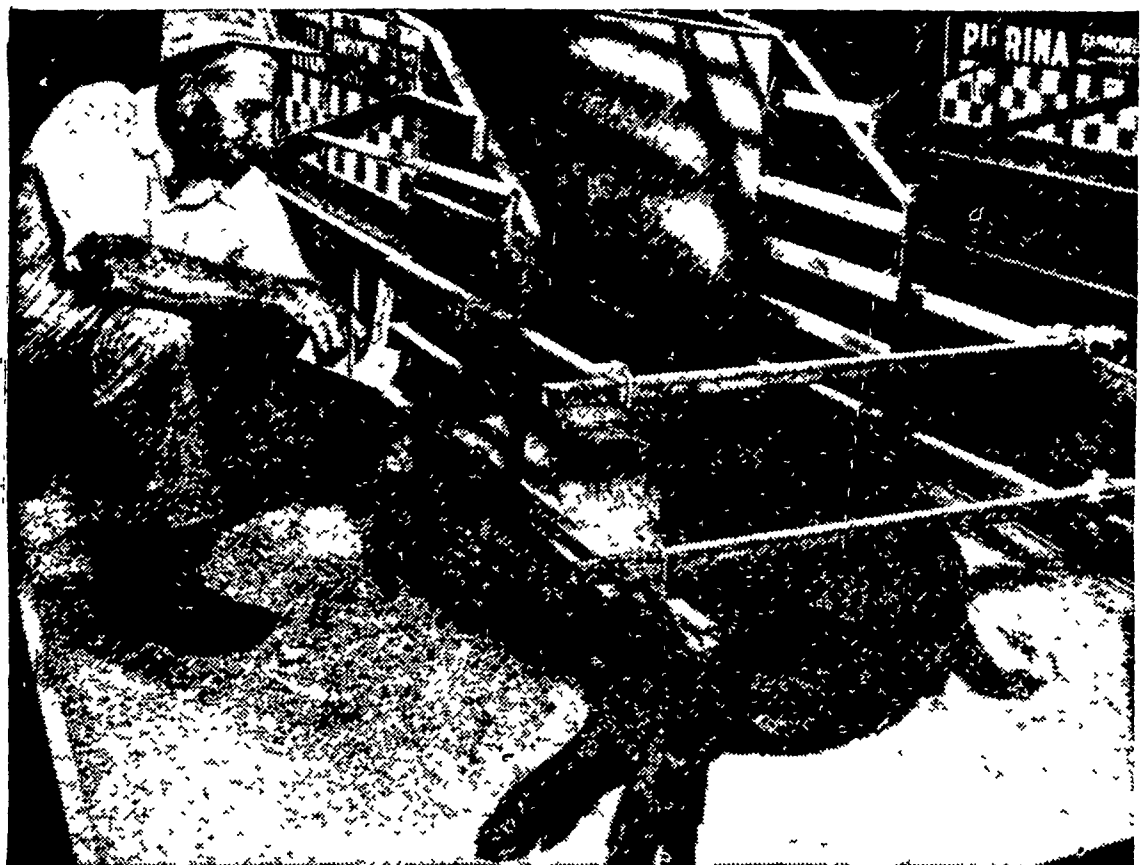

## Holstein Production Records Reported For Local Dairymen

Milk and butterfat production levels established by Registered Holstein cows in this area have been reported by Holstein-Friesian Association of America. All cows are from herds enrolled in the Dairy Herd Improvement Registry (DHIR) official testing program.

Cows recognized in this area, and their owners are as follows: Star Mata Hays, a nine-year-old owned by Hiram S. Augst, Elizabethtown, produced 18,280 lbs. of milk and 818 lbs. of butterfat in 305 days.

El-Lyndo Pietetje Haven Pansy, a five-year-old owned by Elam Bollinger, Manheim, produced 18,390 lbs. of milk and 755 lbs. of butterfat in 317 days.

Brak-Vil Paige Patsy Ivanhoe, a four-year-old owned by Isaac M. Brubaker, Lititz, produced 16,670 lbs. of milk and 694 lbs. of butterfat in 351 days.

Fultonway Rachel Annette, a three-year-old, produced 23,880 lbs. of milk and 895 lbs. of butterfat in 363 days; Fultonway Ivanhoe Pattie, a seven-year-old, had 24,600 lbs. of milk and 894 lbs. of butterfat in 305 days; Suny Glo Star Osbornedale Ann, a three-year-old, had 20,340 lbs. of milk and 777 lbs. of butterfat in 305 days. All are owned by J. Mowery Frey & Son, Lancaster.

Groffdale Reroyal Lill, a four-year-old owned by Robert C. Groff, Quarryville, produced 21,720 lbs. of milk and 819 lbs. of butterfat in 335 days.

Nancy Leader Knollwood, a seven-year-old, produced 20,370 lbs. of milk and 926 lbs. of but-

terfat in 322 days. Inka Star Betty, a seven-year-old had 20,470 lbs. of milk and 801 lbs. of butterfat in 322 days. Red Rose Nancy Skyliner, a five-year-old, had 21,600 lbs. of milk and 782 lbs. of butterfat in 327 days. All are owned by Red Rose Research Center, John W. Eshelman & Sons, Lancaster.

Pleasant Grove Lucinda Dean, a 10-year-old owned by Charles C. Tindall, Peach Bottom, produced 20,860 lbs. of milk and 862 lbs. of butterfat in 305 days.

These new production figures may be compared to the estimated annual output of 8,513 lbs. of milk and 315 lbs. of butterfat by the average U.S. dairy cow, notes the national Holstein Association.

Pennsylvania State University supervised the sampling, weighing and testing operations in cooperation with the Holstein organization's herd and breed improvement programs.

The Commonwealth produced 9,120,000 hundredweight of potatoes in 1967 of which 84.5 percent, or 7,707,000 cwt., were sold. Largest purchasers were processors of food products accounting for 42.1 percent of total sales, according to a survey by the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service. The remainder was sold for fresh market, seed, and livestock feed.

The portion of the crop not sold was utilized as seed used on the farm where grown, household use, and feed, and also some shrinkage and loss.
