farm near Pretoria, was in Harrisburg this week for the second World Holstein-Friesian Conference which was attended by representatives of 21 nations.

He explained, after the sale, that his purchase was the first step in a program to introduce new blood lines into his herd of about 100 head of cattle.

"Vogan Farm Reflection Jewell" was bred to Osborndale Ivanhoe, a blood line Dr. Laubscher believes will improve his herd. The heifer was sired by Romandale Reflection Marquis, and the dam is Paulridge Supreme. She was consigned by Dr. D. E. and Katherine Vogan, of Mercer.

The animal purchased was one of 31 auctioned at the Holstein sale. The average price was \$1,208 per head, highest in the history of the state sale. Last year's average was \$1,027.08 per head for 41 animals.

Highest price of this year's sale was \$2,600 paid for a 6-year-old, "Har-Gal Abbecker Supreme," by R. Peter Heffering and Ken Trevena, of Amenia, N.Y. The animal—consigned by Paul J. King, of Cochranville, Chester County—was sired by



The animal was sired by Wis Captain and the dam is Erwindale Beth Ijon. She was consigned by Sheldon A. Corl, of State College, and Tussey View Farm, Inc., Centre Hall.

Third highest price was the \$2,300 paid by Dr. Laubscher for "Vogan Farm Reflection Jewell." An Ivanhoe daughter classified Very Good 87 traded homes in the county. 
