Charolais Breeders Help Viet Nam Beef Production

ROCKVILLE, Ind (Special)—While U S soldiers are fighting to improve living conditions for South Viet Nam citizens, two Rockville, Indiana, Charolais breeders have completed the first major effort from the American livestock beef producers to improve beef production in that beleaguered country

Two hundred vials of semen from a Charolais bull, Argo Adams 710, arrived in Saigon airport recently for use in the only government-controlled herd of native cattle in Viet Nam. The semen will be used in a vocational research program developed between the South Viet Nam and U S Government

Cleared by the U S Department of State for entrance in the country, the frozen semen was carried to Viet Nam by Capt. Barry Morton, a Rockville, Ind., Charolais breeder and reservist on special duty in Saigon. Capt. Morton is on military leave from his position as professor of social studies at Indiana State University

Working closely with Capt. Morton in the project was Manager Joe Edwards of Adams Farms, Inc., of Rockville. Edwards helped collect and prepare the semen for shipment. The bull, Argo Adams 710, is a son of Adams' senior herd sire, Don Argo 001

Edwards said the shipment of semen was originally scheduled for late spring of this year for use in a government-controlled herd north of Saigon. However, a push by the North Vietnamese ended in the slaughter and ultimate consumption of those cattle by the Viet Cong
