## NH To Close Farmec Plant

Operations at the Farmec plant at Intercourse will be consolidated with New Holland facilities effective December 31, 1968 according to J. Paul Lyet, II, vice president and general manager of the New Holland Division of Sperry Rand Corporation.

In announcing the closing of the Farmec plant, Lyet said that manufacturing operations will be integrated into other company plants.

It is expected that most of the people of the Farmec plant will be employed at the facilities in New Holland.

The New Holland Farmec Division occupies the former Smoker Farm Elevators, Inc. plant which New Holland acquired in October, 1958. The division manufactures silage and feeding equipment systems, conveying systems and liquid manure handling systems.

### Freezer Operating Costs

It costs no more to operate a freezer full of food than it does an empty one. Yet U.S. Department of Agriculture specialists found that only about half the families who own home freezers keep them even three-fourths full. About 40 percent of the space is filled with meat; about 35 percent with fruits and vegetables.

## Career Production For Area Holsteins

Lifetime milk and butterfat production levels for Registered Holstein cows in this area have been announced by Holstein-Friesian Association of America. The individual animals have been credited with career food production totals exceeding 100,000 lbs. (49,000 quarts) of milk. The official testing program is sponsored by the Association and supervised by the state and local testing organizations.

Because of the high cost for herd replacements, cows that stay in the herd longer and achieve high lifetime production have proven to be more profitable. The Holstein Association has nearly 29,700 cows on file that have attained the 50-ton production milestone.

Local Holstein breeders and their long-time producers reported by the organization include:

Strickst Ivanhoe Cheerio (G-P), 102,332 lbs. of milk and 4,594 lbs. of butterfat in 2,228 days. She is owned by Hiram S. Aungst, Elizabethtown.

Henket Daisy Ivanhoe (GP), 100,300 lbs. of milk and 4,305 lbs. of butterfat in 2,381 days. She is owned by Henry E. Kettering, Lititz.

Nancy Leader Knollwood (V-G), 111,799 lbs. of milk and 4,931 lbs. of butterfat in 2,320 days; Inka Star Betty (VG), 110,750 lbs. of milk and 4,326 lbs. of butterfat in 2,350 days. Both are owned by Red Rose Research Center, John W. Eshelman & Sons, Lancaster.

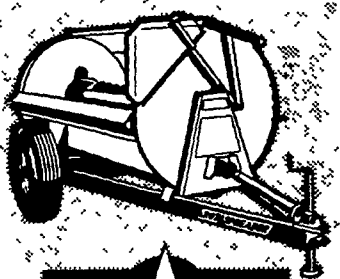

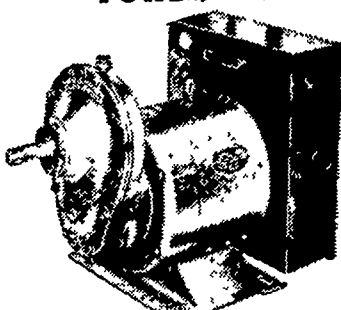

several types. As a rule, the lighter the color of honey, the milder the flavor.


### Refrigerate Bananas?
