




FOR OCTOBER 1968

PRECIPITATION is expected to be subnormal over most of the Nation except for near normal amounts in the Great Labore Region, the northwest Pacific coast, and the Guif and South Atlantic states, with heavier amounts in Florida.

TEMPERATURES are expected to average below seasonal normals over most of the Nation except for above normal temperatures in the Pacific coast states and near normal temperatures over the northern third of the country between the Rockies and the eastern **Great Lakes**




