James G. Kreider, Quarryville R1, were re-elected and Robert Harnish, Conestoga R1 and Earl Martin, Ephrata R1, were newly elected. Noah Wenger, Stevens R1 and John Charles, Millersville R1 chose not to run for reelection.

The group adopted all 13 recommendations of policy. They are:

1. We are opposed to a guaranteed annual wage;
2. We recommend the firearms act be enforced and registering of firearms opposed;
3. We recommend that permanent practices of conservation be exempt from the Department of Agriculture budget cuts;
4. We recommend a PFA study

of preservation of Class I and II farm land;

5. We protest the exploitation of land owners when installing sanitary sewers and gas lines in Lancaster County;

6. We recommend that every able man on relief be required to work an 8 hr. day or be trained in an occupation to make himself sustaining;

7. We recommend the income tax per person deduction of \$600 be updated;

8. We recommend additional revenues needed for highway building be raised through fuel tax increase, not a truck license increase;

9. We recommend seasonal permits to move large farm equipment up to 186 inches.

10. We support present legis-

lation opposing highway land grab;

11. We recommend legislation be passed allowing farmers to dispose of animal waste in customary ways;

12. We recommend all milk trucks be so identified;

13. We recommend the possibility looked into by PFA state directors of senior men being hired for some service work jobs.

**Tindall Has 1,000 lb. Cow**

BRATTLEBORO, Vt. — Another official production record equalling a half ton of butterfat has been completed by Pleasant Grove Lucinda Dean (GP), a Registered Holstein cow owned by Charles C. Tindall, Peach Bottom. This is the fourth time that "Lucinda" has achieved the

1,000 lb. butterfat production level in a single lactation. This record ranks among 2,573 similarly completed by Registered Holstein cows on official test.

The Pennsylvania Holstein's official record of production totaled 23,744 lbs of milk and 1,000 lbs of butterfat in 365 days. She stated her lactation at the age of 10 years and 7 months and was milked twice daily.

"Lucinda" was bred in the Tindall herd. She was sired by Maplebend Dean King Posch (VG) a bull that has earned a Gold Medal sire recognition.

Pennsylvania State University supervised the weighing and sample testing of her production in cooperation with the Dairy Herd Improvement Registry program of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America.

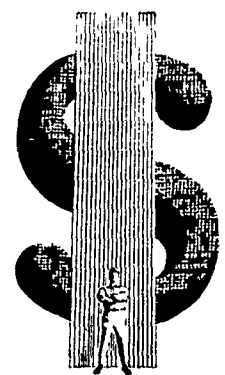
