Symposium To Hear Dr. Cooper

Herbert K. Cooper, D.D.S., founder and director, Lancaster Cleft Palate Clinic, Lancaster, will speak on "When Is a Cripple Not a Cripple" during a symposium on Dental Care for Health, Esthetics, Self Respect and Dignity, at the 1968 Convention of the National Easter Seal Society for Crippled Children and Adults, to be held at the Sheraton Boston Hotel, Boston, Mass., November 13-16.

A graduate of Franklin and Marshall College and the University of Pennsylvania Dental School, Dr. Cooper is past president of the Pennsylvania 5th District Dental Society and the Pennsylvania Dental Society. He is a director of the Conestoga National Bank, Lancaster; chairman of the board, Linden Hall Academy, Lititz; honorary member, Rotary Club of Lancaster; and an active member of the Moravian Church, Lititz.

The theme of this year's Easter Seal convention is "Focus on People." Among the major topics to be discussed will be the Easter Seal Society's basic Information, Referral and Follow-up Program; new methods and approaches of delivering rehabilitation services; dental care for the handicapped; and new scientific developments in rehabilitation.
