



AVERAGE MONTHLY WEATHER OUTLOOK

Weather Bureau Extended Forecast Division

FOR NOVEMBER 1968

PRECIPITATION will exceed normal along the West Coast, the west and central Gulf Coast, and over much of the Northeast. Sub-normal rainfall is expected over the Rockies, the Central Plains, and the upper Mississippi Valley. Near normal totals are in prospect elsewhere.

TEMPERATURES are expected to average below seasonal normals over the southeastern third of the Nation with greatest departures in the South Atlantic and East Gulf States. Predominantly above normal temperatures are expected over the western half of the country. In unspecified areas near normal averages are indicated.

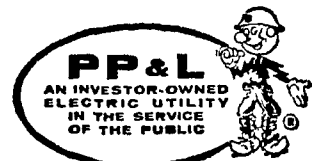
