Deer are being killed at a near-record rate this year on Game Commission this week urged motorists to be especially alert during the next two months.



occur during November and December than during any other year. Whitetails are disturbed by hunters during the small game season, which is underway in the Keystone State; and move about with increasing Pennsylvania highways, and the frequency during the two-month period.

Drivers, especially those traveling at night, should be con-stantly alert for deer which may suddenly bound onto the road in front of vehicles, Reduced speed lessens the danger.




