

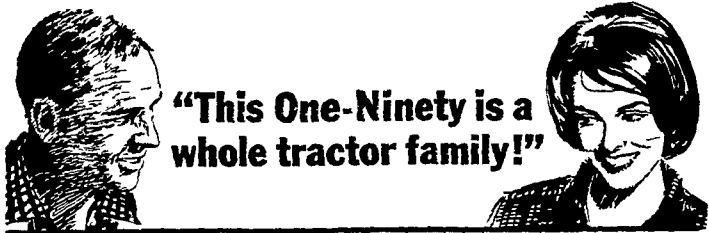

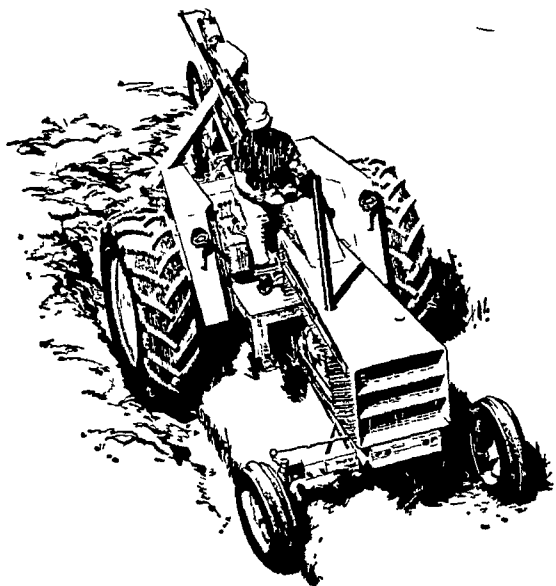
At the present moment the future exists nowhere except in men's minds.

County 4-H Members Compete In State Horse & Pony Show

Months of intensive practice and a lot of self-determination paid off for several county 4-H Club members last week when they won awards at the State 4-H Horse and Pony Show in Harrisburg (November 15-16).

The winners and their placings are as follows: Nancy Lyn Henkel, R. D. 1, Strasburg, first place in Hunter Seat Equitation, Junior Division; Thomas J. Hamill, R. D. 1, Mount Joy, second place in Saddle Seat Equitation and Cathy Reinhold, R. D. 2, Columbia, third place Western Pleasure Class.

Several other county horse club members also competed in the state contest and received participation ribbons. They were: Nancy Weber, Letort Road, Millersville; Kirk Bussell, R. D. 1, Manheim; Steve Mitchell, Refton; Randy Glick, Bareville; Shirley Craig, R. D. 2, Nottingham and Robert Hershey, Manheim.

Riders and their horses, winners of county and district eliminations, were entered in 25 different classes with members from each district in the Commonwealth competing. Approximately 375 contestants from most counties were entered in classes.

Associate County Agent Jay Irwin said classes in the state contest gave club members an opportunity to exhibit their skills in horsemanship and their ability to groom a horse for showing.

He reports the primary purposes of the State 4-H Horse and Pony program are to develop riding skills; gain self-confidence by competing in shows;

practically every type of riding- which is popular today.

The junior event was part of the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition which was held last week in the State Farm Show Building. The state show climaxes the year for more than 5,000 Commonwealth 4-H members enrolled in horse project work.
