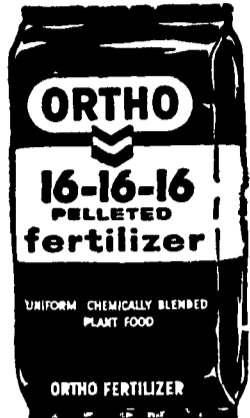

## Keep Christmas Puppy Healthy; Feed Right

Small puppies — like small children — need special attention at feeding time, says Dr. Robert Hammond, University of Maryland Extension veterinarian.

Feed a puppy small amounts often and keep everything clean.

"When he first comes to you, feed him 4 or 5 times a day. For the first few days, feed him the same kind of food he has been eating. If you are going to change, do it very gradually," Dr. Hammond suggests.

Feed your puppy only the amount that he will clean up in a few minutes. Take the remaining food away and wash the dish.

From 10 weeks to 6 months of age feed three times a day. From 6 months to a year twice a day is often enough. For dogs over 1 year old, once a day is enough, but some owners prefer twice a day feeding. It is a matter of preference. If he gets too fat just reduce the amount.

Keep clean, fresh water available at all times.

Never give your dog small bones that are likely to splinter — especially bones from poultry. He will enjoy a large beef bone occasionally and it will help tooth development.

Give your dog a balanced diet. Commercial dog food usually provide adequate nutrition, but special prescription diets are available and are sometimes prescribed by veterinarians.

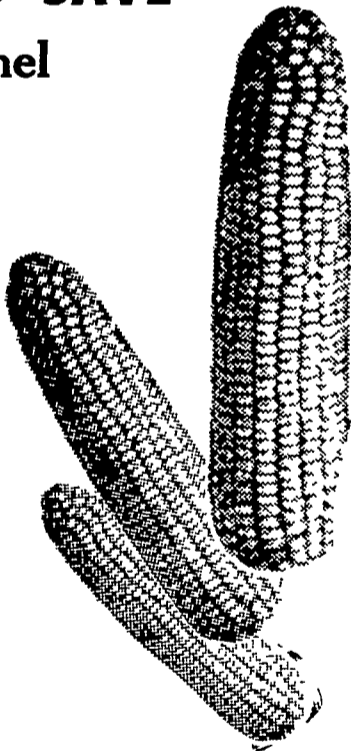
