THE SALE

In the afternoon sale the grand champion sold for \$119 a pound to Hershey Motor Lodge, and Gary Dean's reserve champion went for 52 cents a pound to the Dutch Wonderland. Mark Hitz, manager of Hershey Abattoir, represented the Lodge and Hildebrand Meats, Strasburg, bought for the Wonderland. Hitz had paid \$115 for the champion last year. The Hereford champ went to

Allen Packing for 35 cents a pound and the reserve Hereford was bought by Watt and Shand for 32 cents a pound.

Hamilton Watch bought the champion Shorthorn for 32 cents and Wiggins Chevrolet bought the reserve Shorthorn for \$20.50.

In all 121 steers sold for a total of \$38,771.55 with an average price of 33.79 cents a pound including the champion.

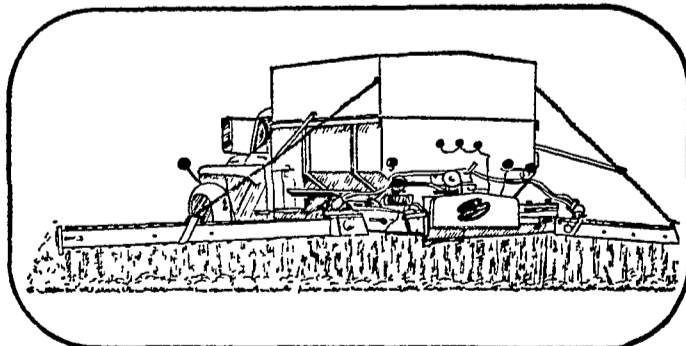
