

Production Records For Holstein Cows

Milk and butterfat production levels established by Registered Holstein cows in this area have been reported by Holstein-Friesian Association of America. All cows are from herds enrolled in the Dairy Herd Improvement Registry (DHIR) official testing program.

Cows recognized in this area and their owners are as follows:

Red Rose Leader Madcap, a four-year-old, produced 18,440 lbs of milk and 864 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Red Rose Double Leader Kate, a four-year-old, had 20,150 lbs of milk and 674 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Both are owned by John W. Eshelman & Sons, Red Rose Research Center, Lancaster.

Fieebaei Fultonway Joanna, a three-year-old, produced 21,723 lbs of milk and 989 lbs of butterfat in 365 days. Fultonway Rachel Ann, a 10-year-old, had 24,186 lbs of milk and 953 lbs of butterfat in 365 days. Fultonway Ivanhoe Monica, a four-year-old, had 25,850 lbs of milk and 921 lbs of butterfat in 365 days. Fultonway Cisscross Regina, a two-year-old, had 17,900 lbs of milk and 900 lbs of butterfat in 361 days. Piebe Osberndale Hartog, a seven-year-old, had 21,710 lbs of milk and 898 lbs of butterfat in 315 days. All are owned by J. Mowers Frey & Son, Fultonway Farms, Lancaster.

Groffdale Reflection Ina, a six-year-old, produced 22,560 lbs of milk and 847 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Groffdale Reflection Delight, a six-year-old, had 23,210 lbs of milk and 785 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Groffdale Belle Boy Abegale, a four-year-old, had 17,210 lbs of milk and 693 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Groffdale Reflection Lollypop, a four-year-old, had 13,430 lbs of milk and 662 lbs of butterfat in 348 days. All are owned by Robert C. Gioff, Groffdale Farm, Quarryville.

Woodson Sovereign Jewel, a three-year-old, owned by John E. Kreider, Lancaster, produced 12,020 lbs of milk and 664 lbs of butterfat in 331 days.

Mill Road Bright Esther, a four-year-old, produced 16,140 lbs of milk and 725 lbs of butterfat in 345 days. Blossomelle Mercè Beau Coup, a four-year-old, had 17,120 lbs of milk and 721 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. Blossomelle Ivanhoe Jerry, a two-year-old, had 16,380 lbs of milk and 613 lbs of butterfat in 305 days. All are owned by Herbert & Rhelda Royer, Lancaster.

Pleasant Grove Lucap, a four-year-old, owned by Charles C. Tindall, Peach Bottom, produced 18,220 lbs of milk and 690 lbs of butterfat in 305 days.

These new production figures may be compared to the estimated annual output of 8,513 lbs (3,959 quarts) of milk and 315 lbs of butterfat by the average U.S. dairy cow, notes the National Holstein Association.

Pennsylvania State University supervised the sampling, weighing and testing operations in cooperation with the Holstein Association through breed improvement programs.
