Checklist For An Expert Shopper

- Always has a list.

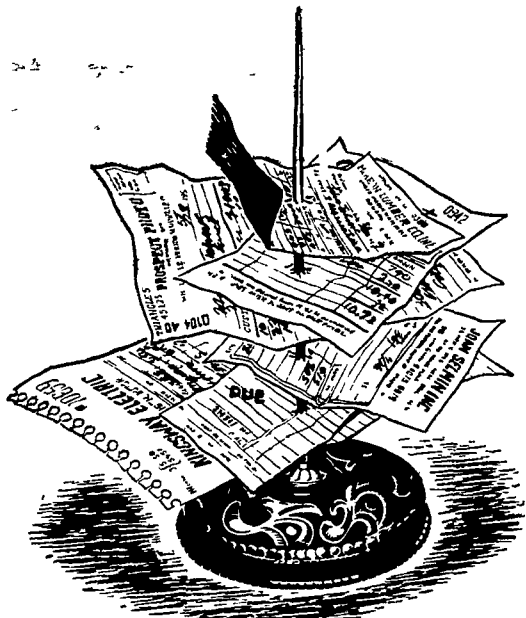

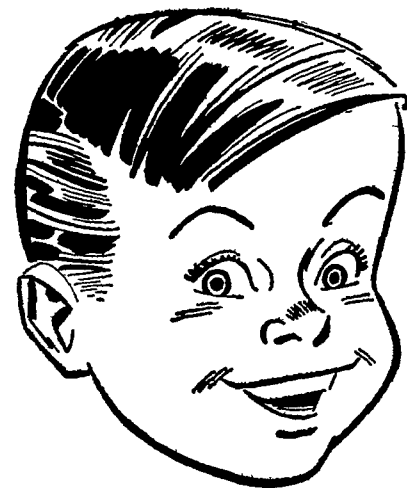
