Farm Show Lacks Space To Satisfy Demands Of Commercial Exhibitors

Ninety-six business firms are on the Farm Show's current waiting list of commercial exhibitors seeking space to display their products, according to Horace L. Mann, Farm Show director.

"Under present conditions, it takes at least four to five years for the application of a commercial exhibitor to reach the top of the list," Mann said.

"We have been able to satisfy the minimum needs of all firms applying up to 1965 and have assigned them space at upcoming show, January 13 to 17," Mann said.

Many commercial exhibitors currently displaying products have indicated a desire for additional space, but settled for minimum footage to gain entrance to the state's big agricultural show held each January, Mann pointed out.

The minimum space desired by exhibitors on the current Farm Show waiting list would require an additional structure

equal to the size of the hog and sheep bams according to Mann.

"We are not only losing revenue," he disclosed "but we have been unable to provide desirable displays of special interest such as one featuring all-new equipment."

Lack of space and facilities have been compounded by the need for new equipment and repairs.

"The farm show has great growth potential," Mann emphasized, "and is at present 'bursting at the seams', limited only by space restrictions."

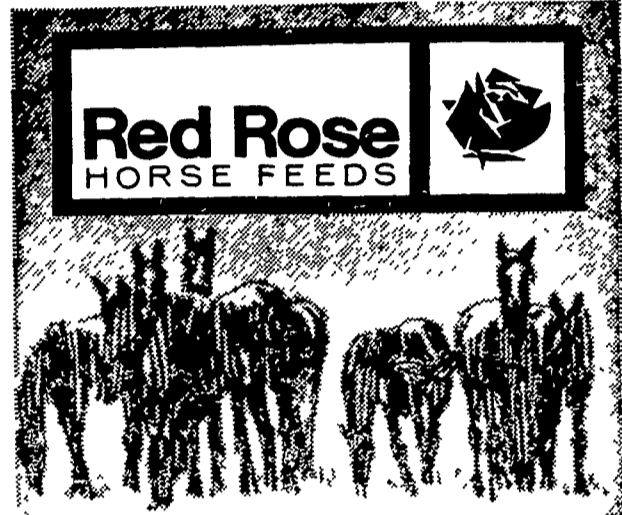
