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the part of feed people and veterinarians. Improved and expanded service has been possible since moving into the new Soil and Forage Testing Laboratory at Penn State University in October 1967. Volume this year already has exceeded last year's totals. The number of standard tests run in December was 1.7 times that for the same month a year ago.

There has also been a sharp increase in the number of special analyses performed. A special test for minerals, nitrates or urea is being requested on about 15% of the samples submitted. These are available at a moderate extra charge beyond

that for standard tests (moisture, protein, fiber, as well as calculated digestible protein, total digestible nutrients, and estimated net energy values).

Feeding programs for all classes of livestock are developed

when requested on special forms available for this purpose. No charge is made for feed programming when forage tests are involved. A modest charge is made for programming on the basis of expected analysis. Over twice as many feeding programs have developed to date this year.

Forage testing and feed programming can be extremely helpful at all times during the year, including the summer feeding period. Dairymen who are not satisfied with production, health or reproduction in their herds, certainly should give this program a good try. 

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
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
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
