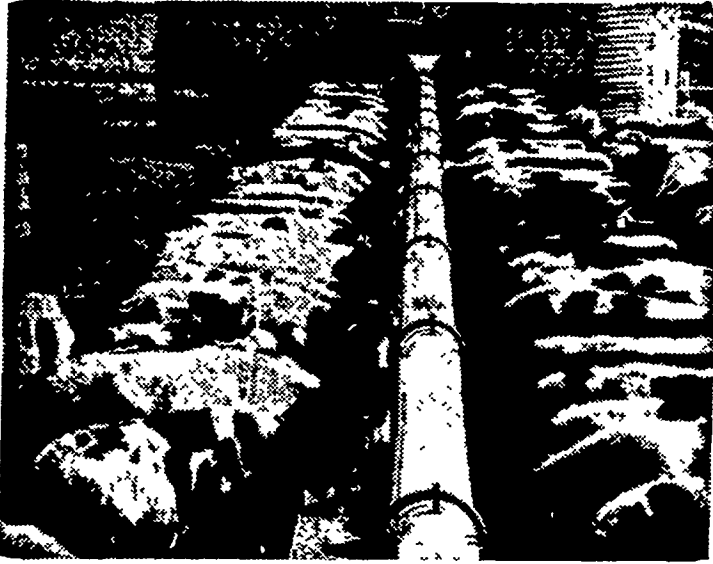

The "tax loss farming" bill (S 500) was introduced by Sen. Lee Metcalf (D-Mont) on Wednesday with 25 co-sponsors. A companion bill (HR 4257) was introduced Thursday by Congressman John Culver (D-Ia) with 5 co-sponsors. The legislation limits writing off of farm losses against non-farm income of more than \$15,000 and should stop the scandalous tax-supported invasion of rural America by Wall Street bankers, entertainers, oil millionaires, and other economically favored citizens. The bi-partisan list of co-sponsors in the Senate reads like an honor roll—Bayh, Bible, Brooke, Church, Eagleton, Harris, Hart, Hartke, Hatfield, Hughes, Kennedy, McCarthy, McGee, McGovern, Mansfield, Mondale, Montoya, Moss, Muskie, Nelson, Pearson, Saxbe, Yarbrough, and Young of Ohio. The House co-sponsors are Frank Evans (Colo.), Lee Hamilton (Ind.), Jonathan Bingham

in Philadelphia. John Maddox, awards chairman made the presentation

and Richard McCarthy (N.Y.), and Henry Reuss (Wis.). Significantly, the list of backers is bi-partisan. Equally important, an impressive list of farm groups has joined the Farmers Union in support of the legislation — Grange, NFO, Farm Bureau, Midcontinent Farmers Association, Farmland Industries Co-op, and the National Association of Farmer Elected Committeemen.
