## Eastern Shore Exchange

Broiler and live fiver prices averaged 18 51 cents a pound this week. Prices ranged from a high of 20 1 cents a pound on Wednesday to a low of 16 8 cents a pound on Tuesday. Sales totaled 542,400 down 134,600 head from last week.

## Eastern Pennsylvania And New Jersey

Prices of light type hens held unchanged, however unconfirmed reports indicate occasional lot moved as high as 10 1/2c or more. Offerings slightly increased in most quarters but still short of current aggressive demand. Movement of hens from up state New Jersey and surrounding area often seriously hampered by severe weather at start of week. Offerings of heavy hens limited and generally short of a fair demand with occasional small lots indicated at

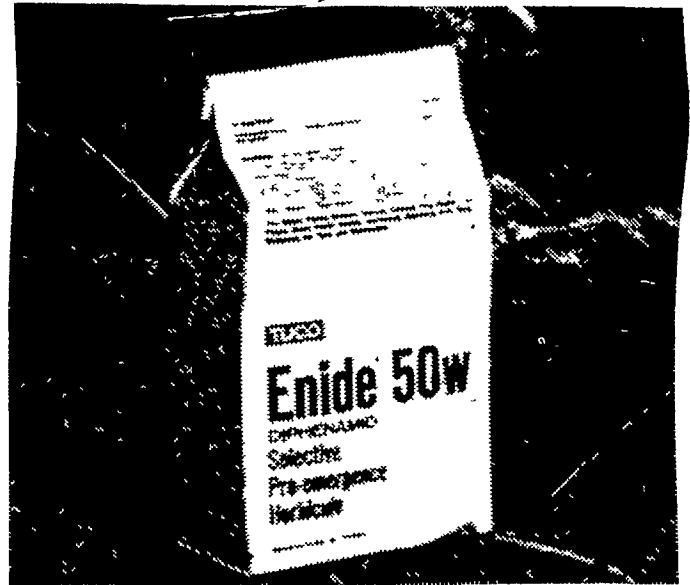
