It's Sping! Almost — and that means home improvement time. Your plan may be as simple as a fresh coat of paint or as elaborate as a plan for remodeling. Whatever your plans are for making home improvements, you'll want to know the right way to avoid costly mistakes.

Two courses to guide you in making improvements around your home are available from The Pennsylvania State University One course titled Improving House and Grounds gives practical ideas for making homes more livable and home grounds more attractive. In addition to a discussion on remodeling and lawns, efficient planning of bathroom, kitchen, and storage areas is discussed. The course sells for \$2.65

The other course is House Farmishings and begins with a discussion on planning. It continues with color, texture, arrangement, lighting, windows, eccessories, and carpets and rugs. This course sells for \$3.45.

If bought together, you may have both courses for \$5.50 You'll want to study both courses before you begin, if you plan to redecorate, remodel, or add furnishings to your home.
