

## County FFA Project Book Winners In State Contest Announced

Lancaster County F. F. A. Members won 43 medals in the State Project book evaluation contests. Henry E. Givler, Area Supervisor of Agriculture Education, announced the results for the county this week. He pointed out that there were less books entered from the county this year, but it produced 13 more medal winners than the previous year and 26 more than in the evaluation 2 years ago. 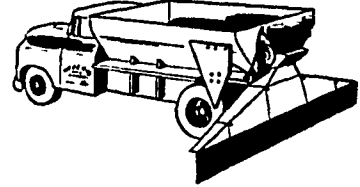

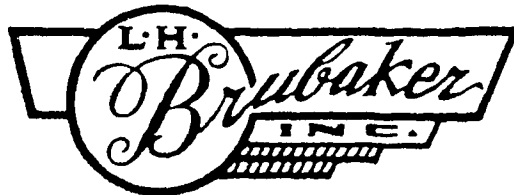
