The livestock population explosion on Pennsylvania farms was rather slight last year. A January 1 inventory of all species indicated that they increased their numbers by only 2 percent for a total of 2,475,000 head. However, their value rose 8 percent to \$441,451,000.

All cattle and calves totaled 1,799,000 head on January 1, up 1 percent from the same date in 1968, and valued at \$240,966,000.

Hogs and pigs showed the largest increase, a rise of 9 percent to 506,000. Value was placed at \$17,255,000.

Continuing a long-time downward trend, sheep and lamb numbers declined by 1 percent. They numbered 170,000, but showed a value increase of 5 percent to \$3,079,000.

The livestock survey is made annually by the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.
