



MILK PRODUCTION

Milk production in Pennsyl vania had its comparative ups and downs during February

Total output for the month was 523 million pounds Compared to February a year ago, this indicated a production drop of 1 percent However, adjusting to the extra day in February of last year, production was actually up 3 percent

Despite the day less this year, production per cow at 720 pounds equaled production for the month in 1968 Milk cow numbers were estimated at 726,-000, one percent less than in milking herds a year ago

It is difficult to slice anything so thin that it has only one side.
