MILK PRODUCTION

Milk production in Pennsylvania had its comparative ups and downs during February

Total output for the month was 523 million pounds Compared to February a year ago, this indicated a production drop of 1 percent However, adjusting to the extra day in February of last year, production was actually up 3 percent

Despite the day less this year, production per cow at 720 pounds equaled production for the month in 1968 Milk cow numbers were estimated at 726,000, one percent less than in milking herds a year ago
