## Is The Egg Outlook Improving?

"The outlook for egg production in 1969-70 may be improving slightly," cautioned Maurice Stein, United Egg Producers' president. "It all hinges on the chick hatch for March and April — and how egg producers react to the possible storm warnings that have been raised. The eggs set March 1 down 3% looks hopeful."

The Poultry Survey Committee recently revised its opinions of the chick hatch for the first 6 months of 1969 from "up 15%" to "up 10-12%." They still believe that the last-half hatch will be up 3-5% above year earlier levels. The hatch during the July-December

ket nailed down in advance for every egg you produce."

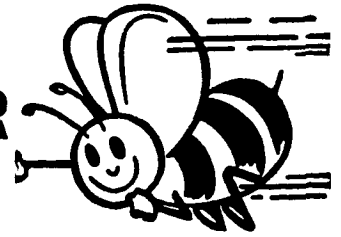
The big question mark in the minds of all egg producers is the "recycled" hens. Is the increased hatch going to replace some of these birds? Many argue — rather unconvincingly — that this is the case and there will not be as many hens on January 1 as the hatch would indicate. "Regardless of the number of hens on January 1, note that the Survey Committee still see a price next fall and winter about 6-7¢ per dozen below what we've had the last 6 months. And that spells trouble for the egg producers of this nation," concluded Stein.

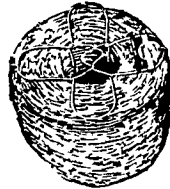
