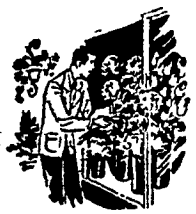

Annual Net Worth Statement Indicates Financial Progress

One of the best indicators of financial progress is the annual net worth statement. However, the annual net worth statement is a reflection of your financial progress over the past year, according to financial planner Helen E. Bell, extension home management specialist of The Pennsylvania State University. She points out:

To find your net worth, add up what you own and subtract what you owe. The results may give you the satisfaction of seeing some financial progress or indicate that you may need to tighten your purse strings.

Miss Bell suggests when adding up what you own that you include cash on hand and in checking and savings accounts, present value of your home and other real estate, value of cars or cars if sold today for cash, and market value of jewelry, antiques and heirlooms. Also add the cash value of your life insurance policies, market value of stocks and present value of bonds, cash value of annuities and retirement plans, money other people owe you, and current value of furniture, appliances, and miscellaneous items.

The next step is to total the money you owe, says Miss Bell. Include mortgages and liens on your house, car or other property, installment debts on household equipment, and house furnishings, personal debts and other bills outstanding. Subtract your total debts from the total of what you own. The result will be your net worth.

Snow Ties

It appears that the season for snow ties is about over for this winter, even though they weren't badly needed at any time in this part of the state. A few tips on the proper storage of snow ties from our engineers: Store them in a cool dry place and lay them flat on a clean surface rather than stand them up. Keep oil, gasoline or other petroleum products away from the ties. Studded ties should be marked, left or right, so they can be remounted in the same position. Studs wear at a slight angle and if mounted on the opposite side some of the studs may come out next winter. Ties that are permanently mounted on extra rims should have the air pressure reduced to 15 pounds and stored similar to other tires. These practices will lengthen the life of the snow ties.
